 - Consult as both presales and post sales roles for technical deployments of ERP solutions in cloud and on prem environments including AWS, Azure, Sage Partner Cloud (SPC) and Acumatica SaaS or PCS.
 - Assist with the development and/or implementation of ISV's solutions and enhancements within the ERP system to meet specific business requirements.
- **Cloud and On-Prem Infrastructure Management**
 - Manage and/or collaborate with external teams to support cloud-based infrastructure, including virtual machines, storage solutions, backup and networking components.

 - Manage Acumatica SaaS and PCS environments including deployments, patches and upgrades.

 - Monitor the performance of cloud-based infrastructure, diagnosing and troubleshooting issues, and making necessary changes to optimize system performance.

 - Provide technical consulting and support for internal and external teams with installation, migration, maintenance and upgrades for Sage X3, Acumatica and Sage 100.
